

Change View Using My Experience User Console

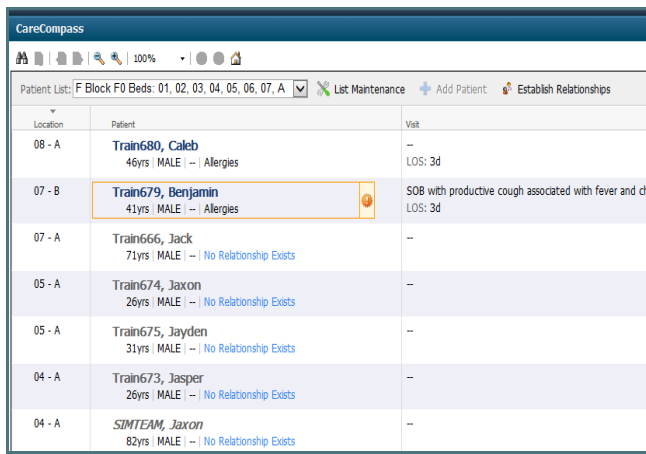
The default view displayed when a user first logs into *ieMR* is dependent on the *Cerner* login and related to which ward or department the user is normally working in. This default can be changed by using the *My Experience User Console* button.

Using My Experience

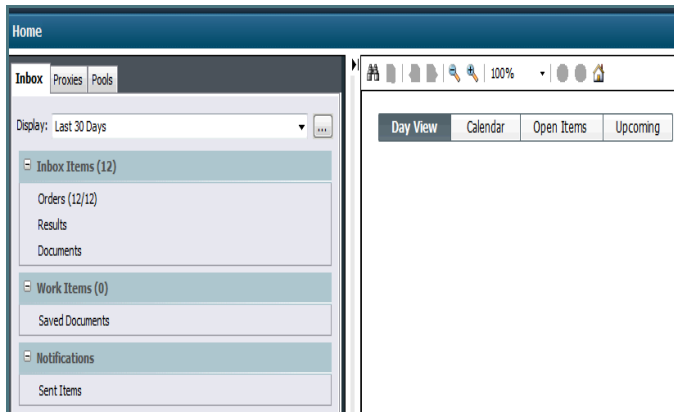
To use My Experience:

1. Log in to *ieMR*.

In the example below, the log in was for a *Ward Nurse* and the “landing page” is *Care Compass*.



As per the next example below, the “landing page” for a *Hospitalist Doctor* is *Message Centre*.

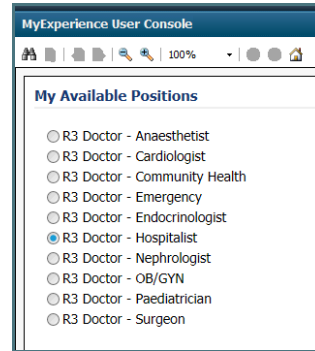


The default “landing page” will be dependent upon the access provided to the staff member for their “usual” position.

2. Click *My Experience User Console* from the *Toolbar* to change the view.

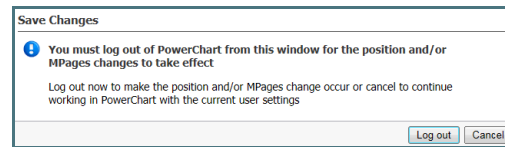


The *My Experience User Console* window will open. The *Available Positions* visible is dependent upon the access of the user.



3. Click in the radio button on the new required console view.
4. Click *Save*.

The following message will appear.




5. Click *Log out*.
6. User will be taken to the *Cerner Log in* screen.
7. Log in using the same login details.

ieMR will open to the “landing page” of the new position selected.

Note: ED Doctors

Doctors who are continually in ED will be assigned to the *ED User Group*. This will allow ED Doctors to see the *ED Launch Point - FirstNet* and use all of its functionality.

Doctors who are not assigned to that user group, for example a cardiologist, will still be able to use *My Experience* to flip to the *ED Doctor* position, however, this will only allow for access to the *ED Tracking List* and not the rest of *FirstNet* functionality.



Only doctors continually in *ED* will be assigned to the *ED User Group* as assigning all Doctors to *ED* will negatively impact the speed of performance of *FirstNet*.
