




e.g. "Met with patient, his wife and social worker to initiate discussions about future withdrawal of dialysis – emotional discussion but both recognised the importance of addressing these issues. Plan: 1. Informed of document options and choices. 2. They will talk further at home and we will discuss at next visit." or "Patient very keen not to have CPR attempted. Plan: ARP created and included in ieMR record".
