



This document is for TUH ED Staff responsible for supplying *Emergency Pack (EP)* take home medications for patients being discharged from the Emergency Department.

Process: Medical Officer to complete and print ieMR discharge script for the EP medication:

1. See list of available EP medications:

| Prednisolone/Phenylephrine 1-1% Eye Drops (Prednefrin Forte) – 10mL |
| Salbutamol 100microgram Inhaler (Ventolin) |
| Sofradex/Otodex (Framycetin/Gramicidin/Dexamethasone) Ear Drops – 8mL Bottle |
| Timolol 0.5% Eye Drops – 5mL Bottle |
| Trimethoprim 300mg Tablet – 7 Tablets |
| Trimethoprim/Sulfamethoxazole (Bactrim) 160/800mg Tablet – 10 Tablets |

4. Nursing Staff to remove appropriate EP meds from Pyxis in Fast Track & return to the Medical Officer.
5. Medical Officer to dispense the medication by completing outstanding instructions on EP med box – fill in the blanks.
6. Medical Officer to stamp or write on prescription “*EP Pack Dispensed*” and sign and date.
7. Medical Officer to provide patient with EP medication and appropriate counselling. This must include a written *Consumer Medication Information (CMI) sheet* – usually found within the EP pack.
8. Medical Officer to place both pages of the script into the discharge tray – *DO NOT* give script to patient.
