

## iView – Setting an Estimated Discharge Date

An *Estimated Discharge Date (EDD)* can be set in *Interactive View (iView)* on the *Patient Medical Record* screen for your patient. This date will then display in *CareCompass* and on the *Patient Summary Discharge* tab. The *EDD* will also pull through into certain *Note Templates* in *Documentation*.

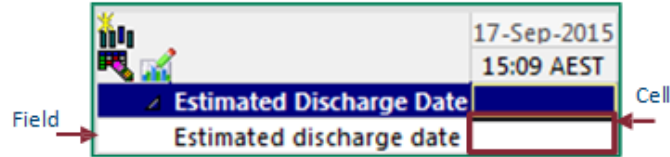
Note: Does not pull from Patient Flow Manager (PFM) or HBCIS

### To set an Estimated Discharge Date

1. Open the patient's medical record



2. Click *interactive View* in the *Patient Menu*.
3. Click on to open the list of options.
4. Click on the *Estimated Discharge Date* section.
5. Double-click on the empty *cell* next to the *Estimated Discharge Date field* to enter your *EDD*.

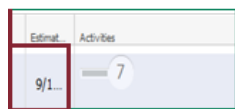


The cell displays a pre-set date entry

6. Press *T* on your keyboard to set the date to the current date.
  7. Press the *+* or *-* Keys on your keyboard to increase or decrease the date by one day.
- Or,
8. Click to select a date from the calendar.
  9. Click *Sign* to finalise the document once the *EDD* has been entered.

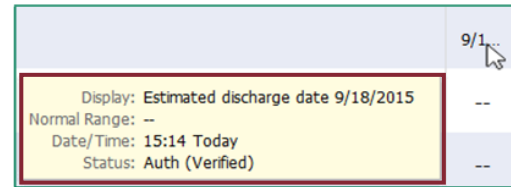
### To view an Estimated Discharge Date

For nurses the *EDD* will now show up in *CareCompass* for that patient under the Banner *Estimated Discharge Date*.

To view the full details of the *EDD* hover the mouse over the date displayed under the *Estimated Discharge Date* banner and a yellow box will appear.



**NOTE:** Due to programming the date format will appear American format as MONTH/DAY/YEAR within *CareCompass* only. This format cannot be changed.

### Estimated Discharge Date in Patient Summary

The *Estimated Discharge Date* is also displayed in the *Patient Summary* screen under the *Discharge* tab.
